# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

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THE DIABETES CENTRE WILL BE A STATE OF THE ART,  
FIRST OF ITS KIND CENTRE IN PAKISTAN.

The grey structure of the 72,000 sq foot 5-storey building has been completed. The boundary wall has been partially completed. The contracts for interior design and landscaping have been awarded. The building will have 32 clinic rooms, laboratory, radiology, pharmacy, specialty clinics for eye care, foot care, diabetes day care, male health, kidney

care, and a dental unit. A conference centre and administrative block would be part of the building. The addition of 4 single bedroom apartments on the top floor will provide accommodation for the visiting doctors and consultant. The project is slated for completion in 2016.

### Red Crescent Visits TDC

... for ERC visit, 11th November 2015

November 11, 2015: Today, A high profile delegation from Emirates Red Crescent (ERC) Abu Dhabi, The Diabetes Centre (TDC) clinic and hospital project at Tal Plaza - Islamabad-Mues Expressway, visited the team and patients attending clinic and reassured TDC management of their assistance in state-of-the-art diabetes centre. Emirates Red Crescent (ERC) UAE and The Diabetes Centre, Inc. (TDC), a non-profit social enterprise in Pakistan signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) last year for establishing a diabetes centre to provide healthcare services to low-income and poor patients on welfare basis.
